



## INTERNET AND TECHNOLOGY AGREEMENT MONTICELLO MIDDLE SCHOOL AND MONTICELLO HIGH SCHOOL

Respect, proper use of educational resources, and **Digital Citizenship** are a large part of the goals and objectives for all students. Inappropriate activities using District-owned devices on the Network and Internet include, but are not limited to the following:

- Sending or displaying offensive or racist messages or pictures
- Using profanity and/or obscene language
- Harassing, insulting, or attacking others
- Damaging devices (Chromebooks), computer systems, software programs
- Violating copyright laws
- Trespassing in another person's folders, work, and/or files
- Using the network or internet for financial or commercial gain
- Using another student's password

Any staff member involved with the use of computers or devices may, at their sole discretion, reserve the right to immediately terminate the privileges of any student who misuses district devices, networks, and systems. Violations could result in additional disciplinary or legal action.

As a parent:

- I consent for my student to access and accept the Internet and Technology Agreement and have reviewed them with my student.
- I will support my student in adhering to this Internet and Technology Agreement.

As a student:

- I understand using the Network/Internet/Chromebook or any technology device at Monticello School District is a privilege and NOT a right. If I abuse the privilege, my access to the Network/Internet/Computer Lab or any technology device may be suspended.
- I understand that transmission of any information in violation of state or federal regulations is prohibited.
- I understand that I may not violate copyright or use the intellectual property of another individual or organization without permission.
- I understand that I may not access, upload, download, send, or share any information with inappropriate language including racist, sexist, or abusive language and content.
- I understand that I may not use the Internet to gamble. I also understand that I may not use the Internet in any way that will result in charges to the Monticello School District
- I understand that I may not alter or destroy any other person's information or use another's password.
- I understand that I should not reveal my or others' address (including email), phone numbers, or any personal info over the Internet, nor the addresses and phone numbers of students, staff, or friends.
- I understand the school has the right to review, edit, or remove any materials installed, used, or distributed on or through the network.
- I understand that I will use the Network and Internet for educational purposes only.
- I understand that I will not use district owned devices for personal, non-school related emails or posts.

- I understand it is a federal law that the school district employ a utility and/or appliance that filters access to inappropriate web content. The use of proxy servers to circumvent the content filter is a violation of the Internet and technology agreement
