Student Internet Contract for Students, Grades 1-5

Little Mountain and Pinewood Elementary Schools

The purpose of the Student Internet Contract is to obtain parent consent for each student who will be using school district owned technology and accessing the internet in school. School Internet access is a privilege and not a right. We support and respect each family's right to decide whether or not to apply for access. We believe that our students benefit from having access to the internet when it is used responsibly to support academic goals of the school district.

Even though an adult will supervise all student use of the Internet, students must be aware of the expectations. Access entails responsibility and presumes that users will honor the Internet Contract. We will be teaching proper etiquette and techniques for using the internet to conduct research and as an educational resource. Activities and searches will be guided by an instructor either directly or by providing a certain topic or address to locate. The websites we visit will enrich the subjects we are studying in class and will be both fun and educational. Our students are excited to find out more about the Internet and vast resources it holds for children.

As a parent . . .

- I consent for my student to access and accept the internet regulations and have reviewed them with my student.
- I will support my student in adhering to this Internet Contract.

As a student . . .

- I understand using the Internet is a privilege and not a right. If I abuse the privilege, my access to the Internet may be suspended.
- I understand that I should not reveal my personal address or phone numbers over the Internet, nor the addresses and phone numbers of students, staff, or friends.
- I understand that transmission of any information in violation of state or federal regulations is prohibited.
- I understand that I may not violate copyright or otherwise use the intellectual property of another individual or organization without permission.
- I understand that I may not access, upload, download, or send any information that is written with inappropriate language.
- I understand that I may not use the Internet in any way that will result in charges to my school.

- I understand that I may not alter or destroy any other person's information or use another's password.
- I understand that I may not enter any chat rooms or use the school computers for email.
- I understand that I may only go to the websites instructed by my teacher.
- I understand that I will use the Internet for educational purposes only to do research and to do assignments from my teachers.
