Monticello 882 Online provides a learning environment that is flexible, self-paced, aligns with the Minnesota State Standards, and provides individualized academic and social emotional supports.

What to Expect in Grades K-5

- ✓ Each full-time student will be provided a computer or tablet. Internet access must be available and supplied by families.
- ✓ Students will access the curriculum through *Edgenuity* utilizing Monticello licensed instructors. Teachers will not be presenting whole-class lessons in the content areas; this will be independent learning time for students.
- ✓ Students will complete all of their school work online with the support of parents, families and licensed teachers. Parents or guardians will be expected to assist their children with online learning in a coaching capacity.
- ✓ Teachers provide guidelines for the completion of work, monitor student progress and provide feedback on assignments and assessments. They are also available for 1:1 instruction when students need help and will communicate with students and families regularly.
- ✓ In the primary grades, students can expect to spend about 30% of their time online and 70% working with offline materials.
- ✓ Students must meet the [admissions qualifications](#) determined to be a successful online learning and will complete a learning contract in order to enroll.

What to Expect in Grades 6-12
