**MONTICELLO SCHOOL DISTRICT IS PROPOSING A \$6,044,546 REFERENDUM ON NOV. 3**

### Classroom Benefits

- Maintain optimal class sizes
- Invest in kids with increased social emotional learning and additional social workers and counselors
- Create programs that directly connect more students to career opportunities
- Increased specialty opportunities (fine arts, languages, tech ed.)



### Transportation

- Increased bus routes to decrease transportation time for students in outlying areas AND to reduce walking perimeter to elementary schools



### Technology/Innovation

- Increase and enhance opportunities through innovation, leadership, and technology
- Make learning more accessible with updated technology devices and collaborative tools for all students



### Activities

- Reduced activity fees
- Increased physical education opportunities
